## **SUPERINTENDENT SCC MEETING RECAP**

### **District updates:**

- \*Apple valley- Fall opening 30th Elementary
- \*ALC-Fieldhouse great new facility  
Available to all 5 schools but specifically assigned to four of the five
- \*flight simulator at the ALC
- \*Technology \$500k to update WiFi
- \*This year and each year forward \$500k put into devices in schools
- \*nebo hero theme- impact in the community- T-shirt's "be your best when it matters most"
- \*critical incident training in every Nebo school in the last 12 months

### **Legislative updates:**

- \*tracking 90 bills- down from the past
- \*if we get any it will be \$80mil from tax reform
- \*funding growth and Weighted pupil unit 2.5% increase just to break even = status quo/breaking even
- \*WPU money is discretionary, we like it \*house bill 293- equalization generates new revenue  
Nebo will always support equalization bills due to our Low assessed valuation and high tax rates
- \*6 legislators: 2 senators and 4 representatives that represent Nebo. Keep legislators informed on how you feel

### **Bond: Nov. 6**

- \*\$298 million with no tax rate increase, extends the life of the bond
- \*3 new middle schools: Salem- valley view middle 2020 Mapleton- Maple Grove 2021 Springville- Spring Canyon 2021/2022
- \*3 rebuild three high schools 2024-2026 to open
