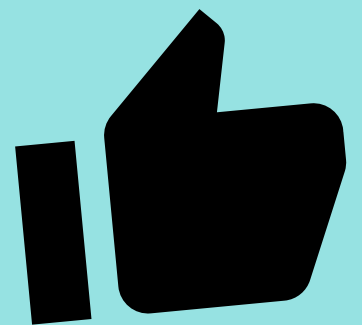
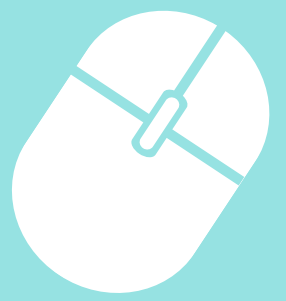

- 4** I will always use good netiquette and not be rude or mean online.
