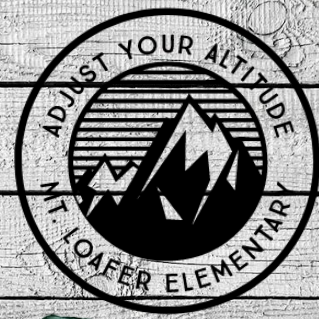

KINDERGARTEN

Parents will have an opportunity to make a preference for **Full Day Kindergarten** or **Half Day Kindergarten**. All students will receive core instruction in reading and math whether they attend a full day or a half day of kindergarten. Children who attend full day kindergarten will receive additional instruction in reading & math as well as more in depth instruction in subject areas such as science, social studies and the arts. Please note that half day students will continue to have social studies and science integrated into their half day of instruction. ROAD CLOSURE & ROUTES

Info from Salem Reach Project: It has come to our attention that Utah County will close the intersection at 11200 South and Loafer Canyon Road (100 East) next week, beginning as early as Monday, May 15, for approximately 10 days. Although this closure is not part of the Salem Reach Pipeline Project, we recognize that it will cause additional impacts/limitations on roadways and access to various locations, including Mt. Loafer Elementary School. Consequently, preparations are in process to open roadways by the end of this week. Another email will be sent tomorrow from Salem Reach with additional information and a map with updated detour routes to help motorists navigate around existing construction zones and help facilitate access during this closure.
