## Discipline Rubric 2022-2023



Dear Parents,

At Mt. Loafer Elementary, our school motto is "United in the Climb". This means that we are a united community, committed to empowering ourselves and others to excel and achieve our full potential as lifelong learners. To support this mission, we use a Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support System in order to improve school-wide behavior and safety. As a Mt. Loafer student, your child will be expected to follow three basic school-wide rules:

## 1. Be SAFE. 2. Be RESPECTFUL. 3. Be RESPONSIBLE.

Using these rules as a foundation, there are academic and behavioral expectations for each student. These expectations will be reinforced and corrected in a positive manner by using the intervention system as stated below. Each teacher has a classroom management plan in place that includes the listed interventions in order to address minor offenses. Ultimately, it is our goal to work collaboratively with parents in addressing behaviors that are not safe, respectful or responsible.

The following behaviors are examples of **Minor Offenses** and will be corrected using the stated interventions:

- Name calling
- Teasing
- Disrespectful attitudes/behaviors
- Making fun, mocking
- Swearing
- Spreading rumors

- Inappropriate notes
- Play fighting, horse-playing, kicking, pushing
- Throwing snow/ice
- Academic & behavioral non-compliance
- Any other offenses as determined by faculty & administration

The following behaviors are considered **Major Offenses** and will be corrected using the following interventions:

- Vulgar/profane language
- Fighting
- Aggressive behavior inappropriate for school
- Intention to harm/hurt
- Stealing
- Sexual offenses
- Harassment (major)

- Destroying or damaging property (vandalism)
- Safe School Violation (illegal activities, possession of fake or real weapon)
- Accumulation of minor offenses
- Any other offenses as determined by faculty & administration

Depending on the severity of the offense, the consequence can vary from what is stated as per district policy.
